

Cut out the game pieces below.


Have an adult help assemble the die.


Fold the player pieces on the dotted lines.


Tape or glue the game boards together.

#### How to Play:


The youngest child goes first. Roll the die. Is the number even or odd? If you are correct, move as many spaces as the number on the die. If you are wrong, you lose your turn.








