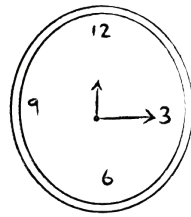

SCHOOL TIME

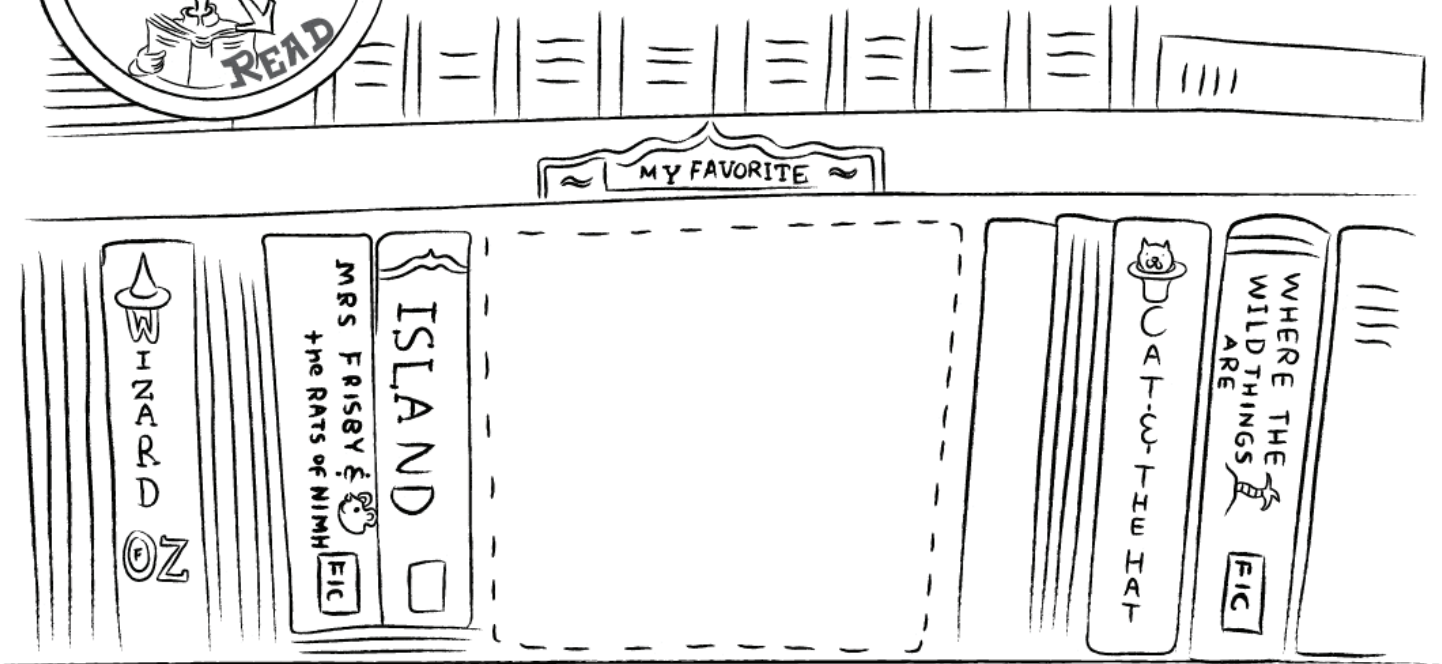
Teachers help you learn and teach you new things. It is important to pay attention when you are in school.

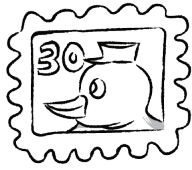

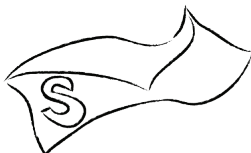
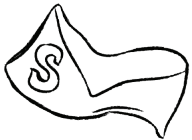
A librarian helps you find books in the library and can read to you, too. Draw a picture of your favorite book in the first box. Then show how a librarian can help you find it in the next box.





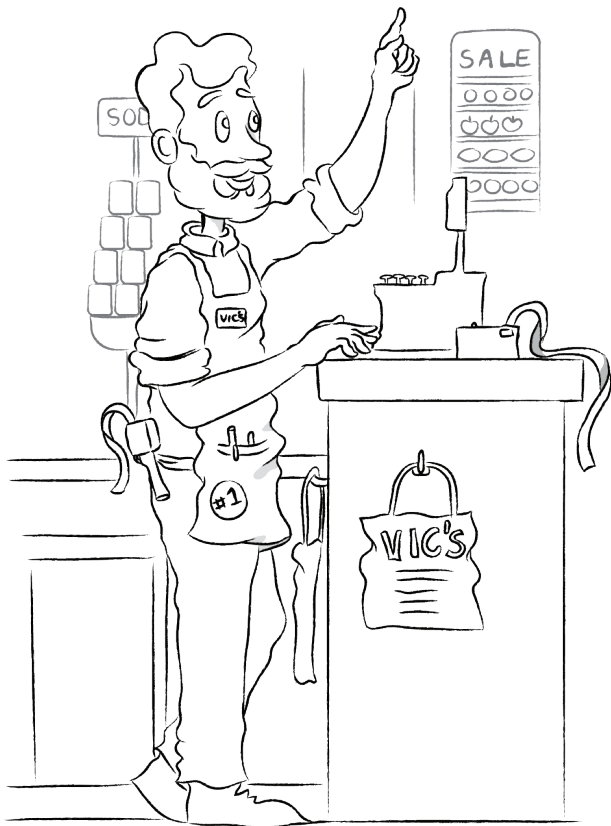
LETTERS

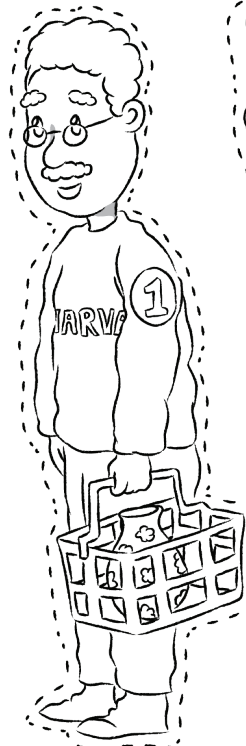
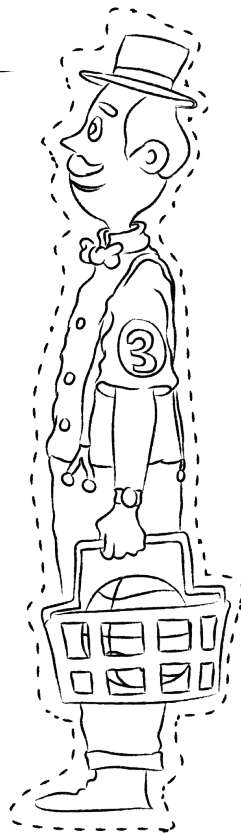


WHERE TO PAY?

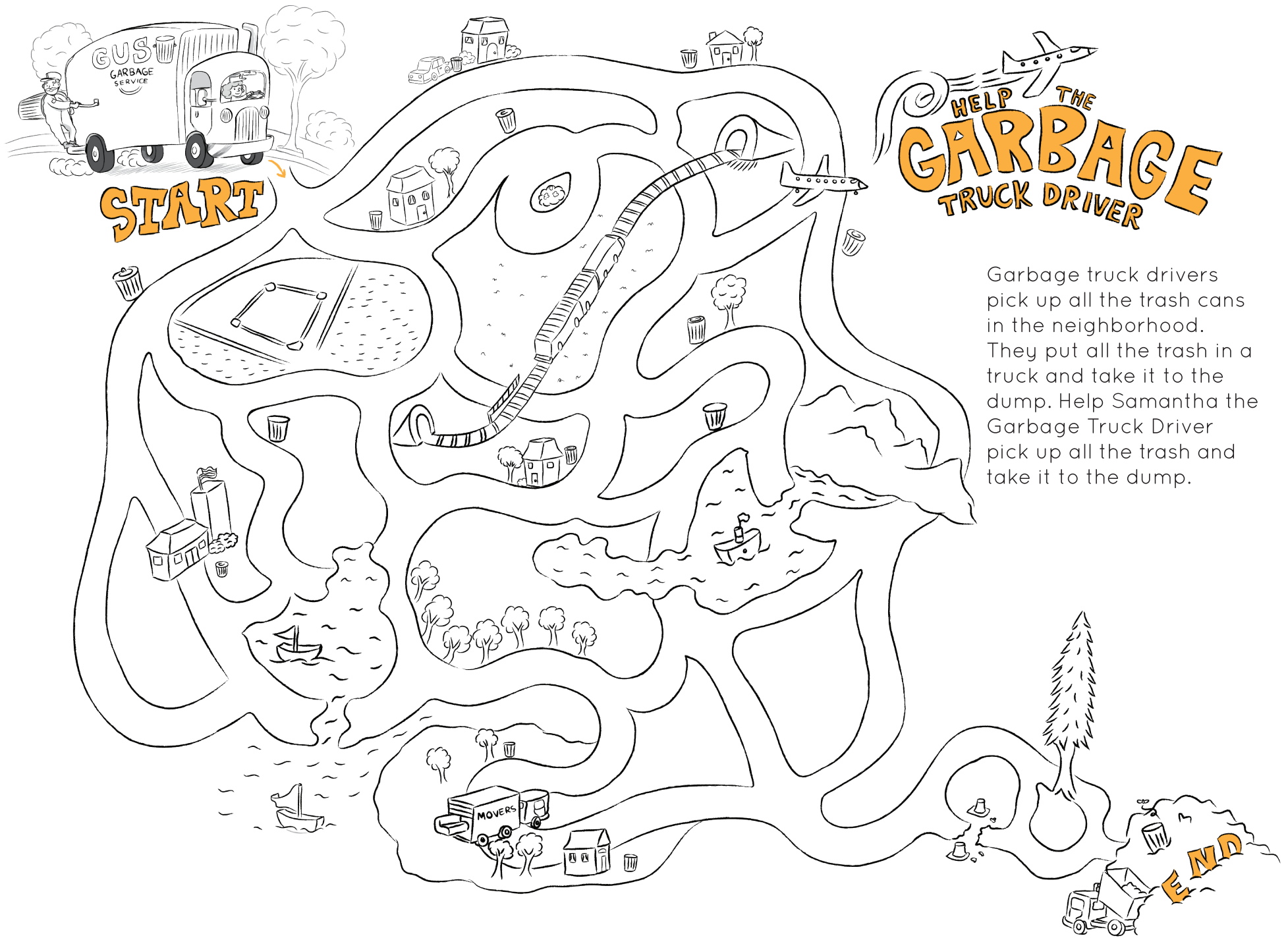

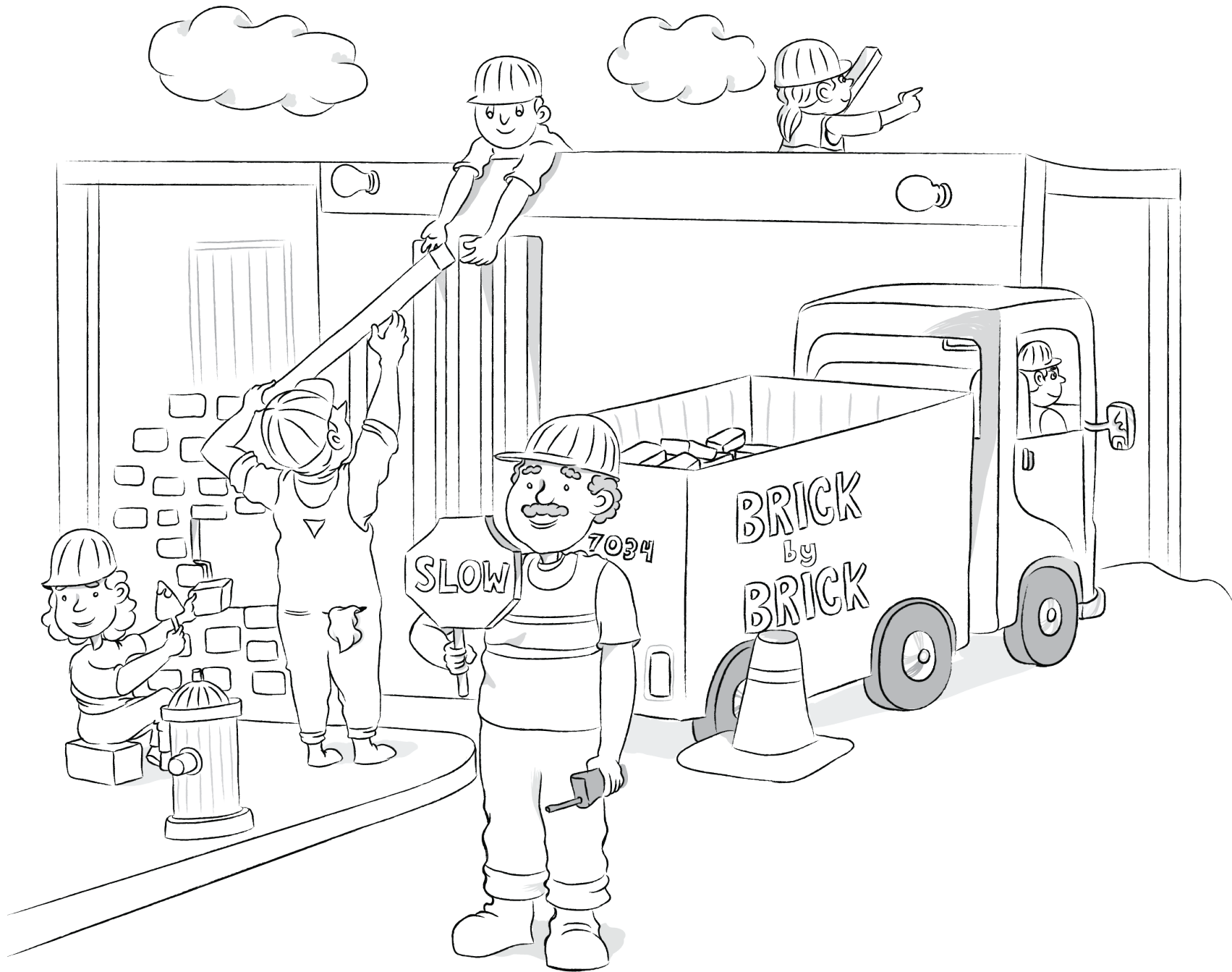
WHAT IS DIFFERENT

Construction workers build new buildings and fix the streets when they are broken. Look at the two pictures and circle what is different on each side.



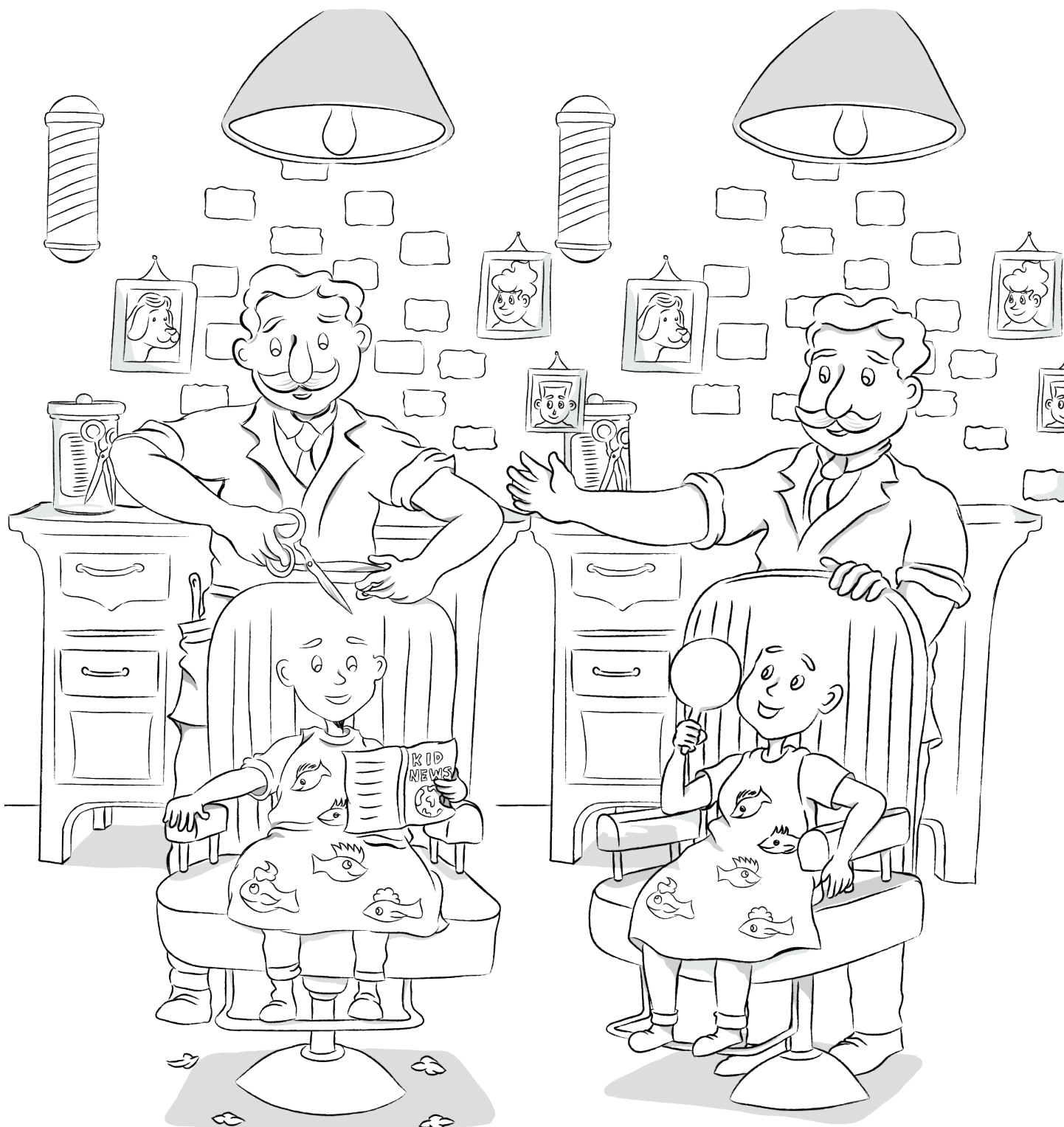

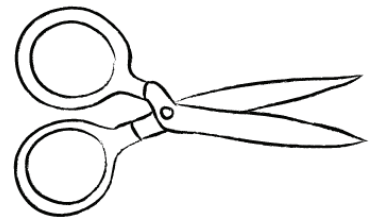
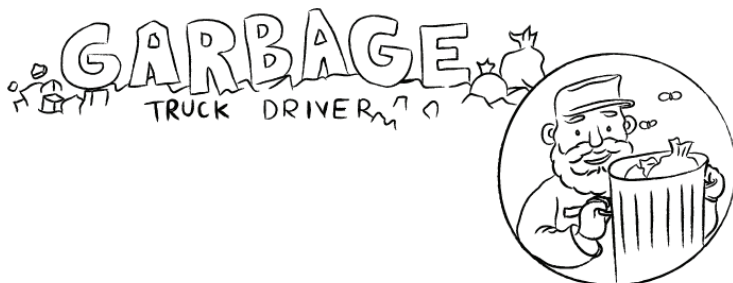
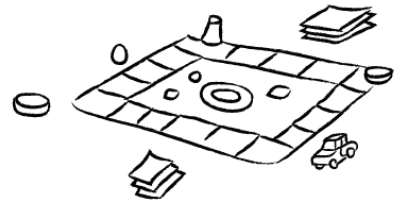
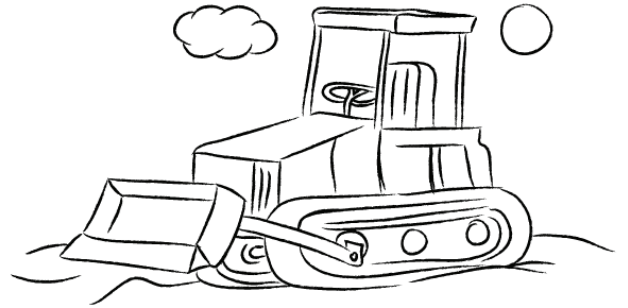
When a babysitter comes to watch you, there are many fun activities he/she might play with you. Find them at the bottom of the page and color them in the picture.

A chef is someone whose job it is to cook food. Circle the things a chef needs to cook dinner for his friends!

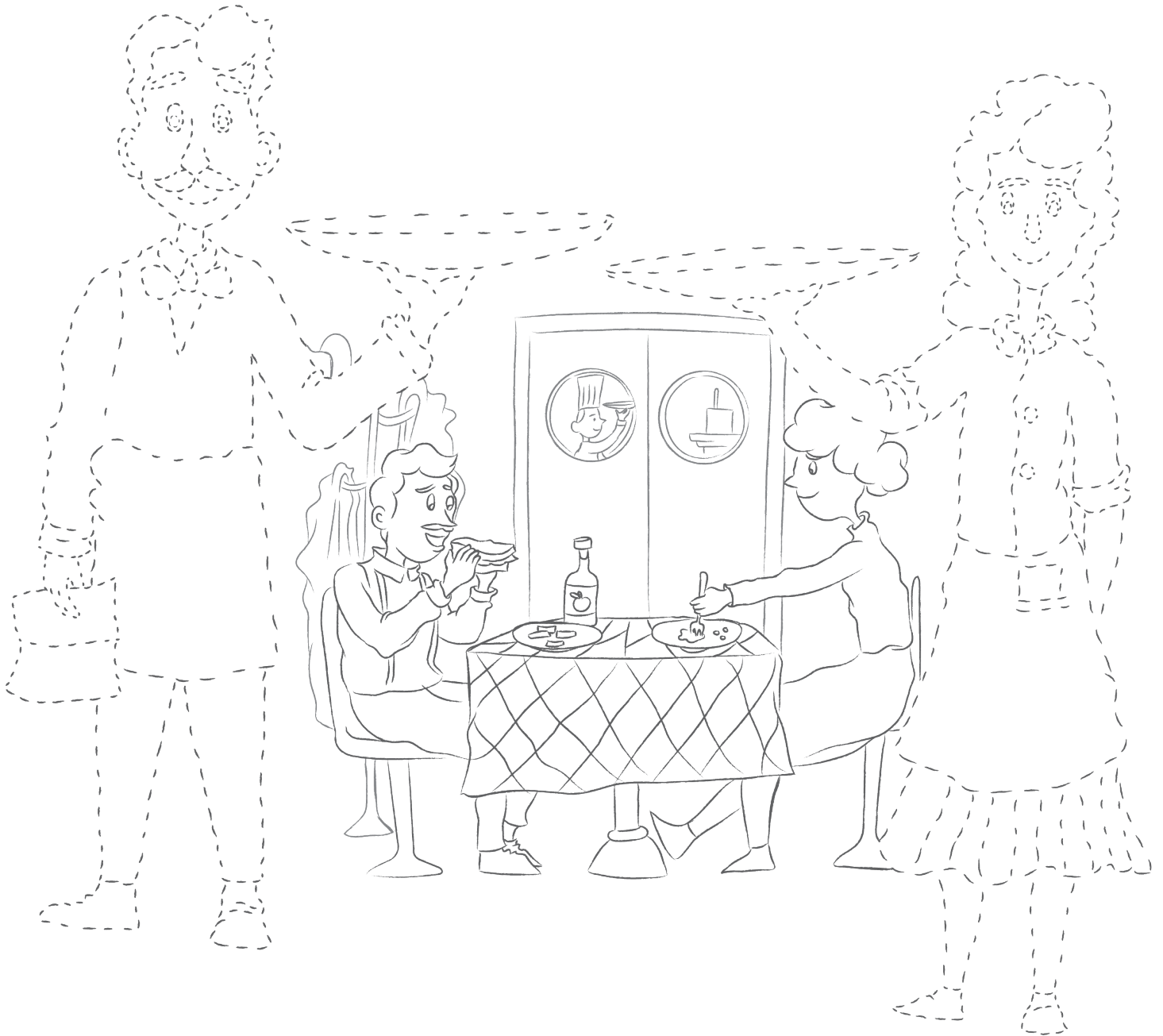


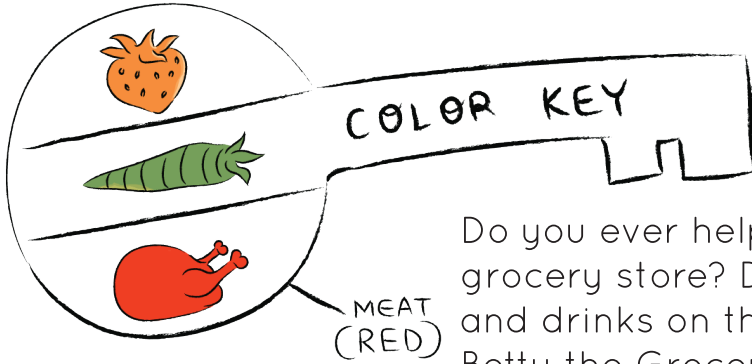
Needs- a rolling pin, mixing bowl, wooden spoon, apron, stove, knife

When you go to a restaurant, a waiter or waitress will bring you your food. Trace the waiter and waitress and draw your favorite food on the trays.

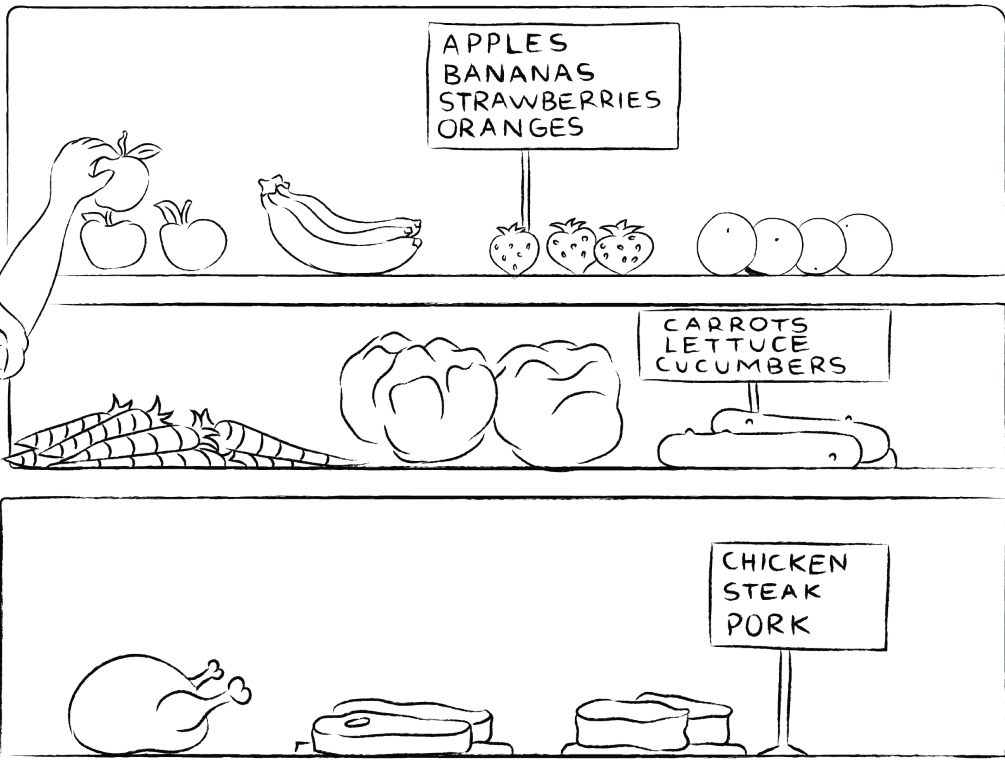

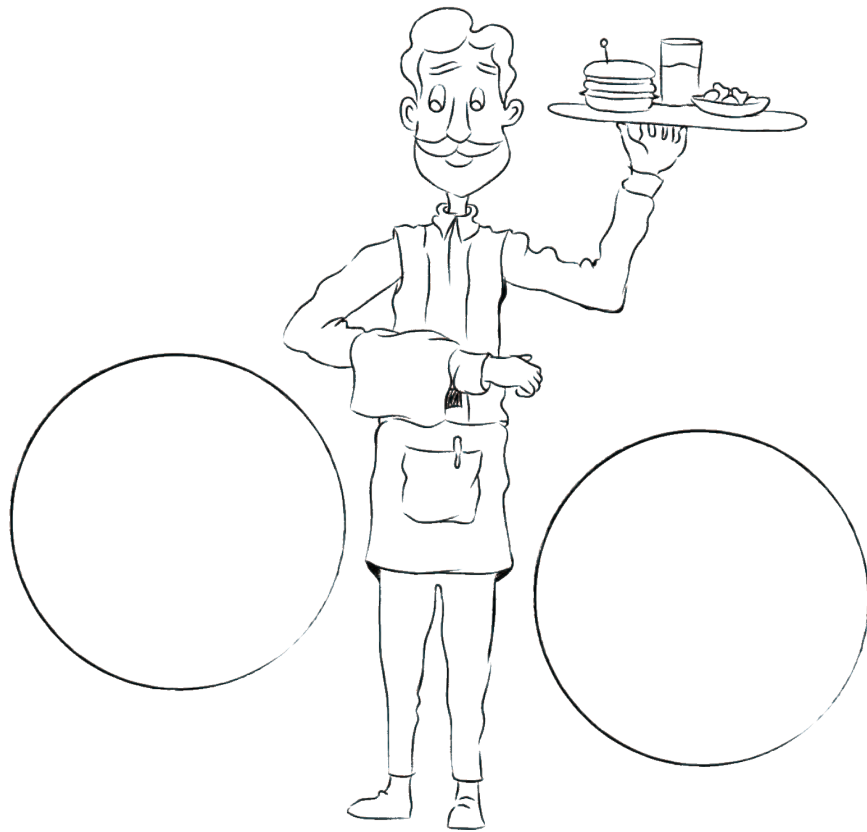


Farmers grow food to keep our bodies healthy and strong. All of these foods are grown by farmers. Circle what belongs next on each line.

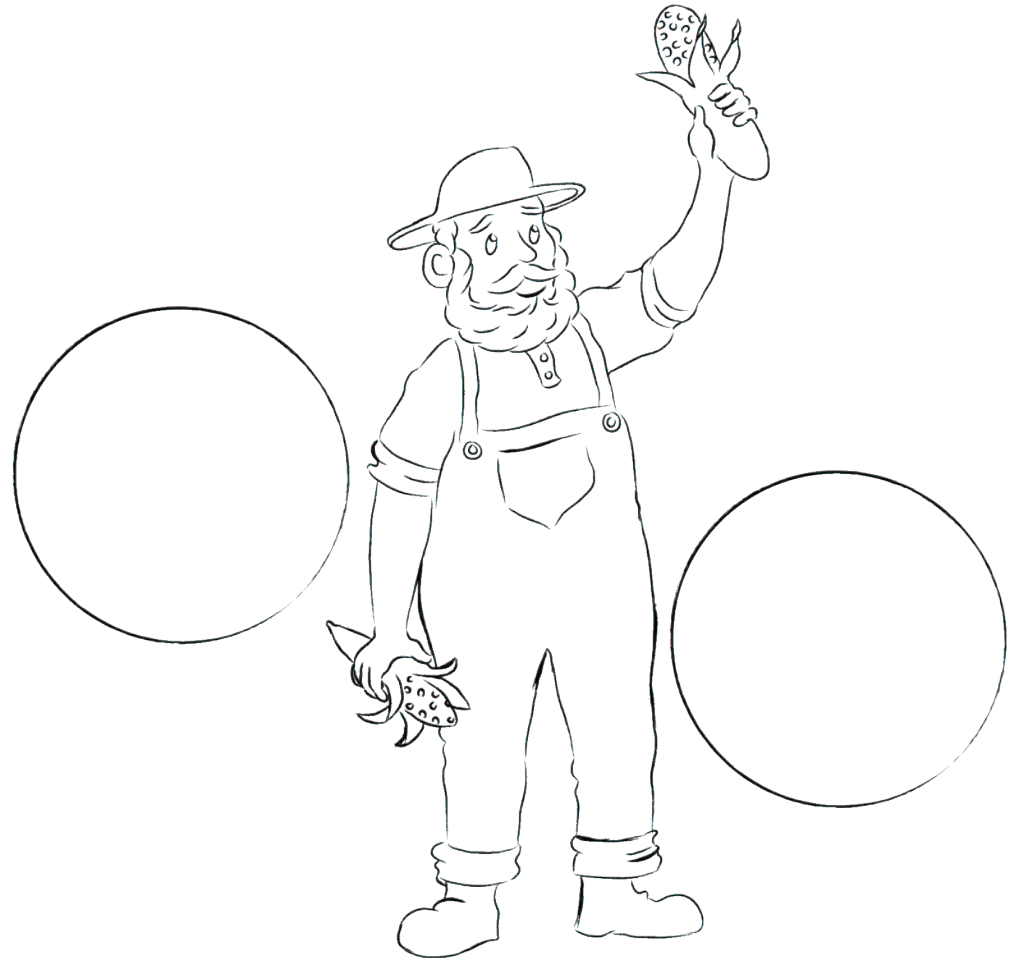
