Step 3: Fold in the left and right points on the red solid lines toward the center so they create a "V" shape.

Step 4: Fold the top point on the solid blue line between the left and right folds.


Step 6: Draw a fun cat face or cut out and glue the face pieces onto the front. Your new friend is complete. Meow!
