


5 Days of Activities


Long Vowel Sounds

- 4. Hang your banner up where you need a positive reminder!










Color and Make Your Own Tangrams




Tangram is an ancient Chinese geometric puzzle where a square is cut into seven pieces that can be arranged to create different figures.

Objective of the puzzle: To form a specific shape using all seven pieces, which may not overlap.




- 1. Print this pattern on cardstock or thick paper so it can be reused.
- 2. Cut out the pieces.
- 3. Print out a tangram pattern card.
- 4. Use all seven of these pattern pieces to recreate the picture on that pattern card.

TIP: Try to create the figure again on plain paper, without using the pattern card as a guide.




Ask your child to recreate this picture using all seven pattern pieces


Print out the next page and cut on the dotted lines. Fold on the solid lines. Follow the instructions below.








- Step 1: Put the gray paper face down. Fold the piece of paper in half from top to bottom. Follow the solid guide lines to make straight folds.
- Step 2: Unfold. Fold the piece of paper in half from left to right.
- Step 3: Fold in the left and right points on the red solid lines toward the center so they create a "V" shape.
- Step 4: Fold the top point on the solid blue line between the left and right folds.



Step 5: Turn over the paper.



Step 6: Draw a fun cat face or cut out and glue the face pieces onto the front. Your new friend is complete. Meow!
