





PRIMARY COLORS: RED


Red is one of the three primary colors. Below are some objects that are red. Color them in.



Now draw and color your own picture of something red.




To make your book of red, first write your name. Then, use red to trace the words and color the pictures. When you are done, cut the pages on the dotted lines and have your parent staple them together!




To make your book of orange, first write your name. Then, use orange to trace the words and color the pictures. When you are done, cut the pages on the dotted lines and have your parent staple them together!


PRIMARY COLORS: YELLOW

Yellow is one of the three primary colors. Below are some objects that are yellow. Color them in.




Now draw and color your own picture of something yellow.








To make your book of green, first write your name. Then, use green to trace the words and color the pictures. When you are done, cut the pages on the dotted lines and have your parent staple them together!

PRIMARY COLORS: BLUE


Blue is one of the three primary colors. Below are some objects that are blue. Color them in.
