- 1968** — Riots break out in Baltimore after the assassination of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

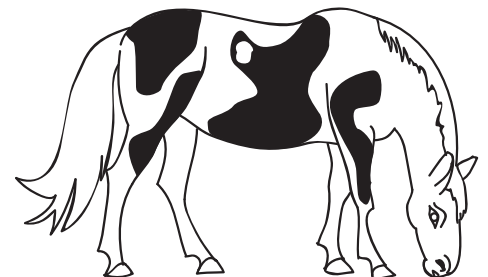
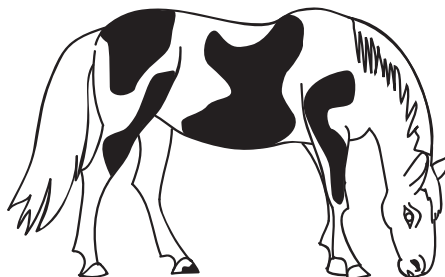

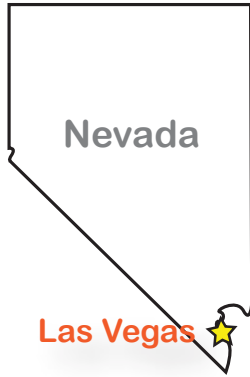

- 1844** Explorer John C. Fremont sets up camp at present-day Las Vegas.
- 1858** Silver is discovered in Nevada.
- 1911** Las Vegas becomes an official city.
- 1931** Construction begins on the Hoover Dam. Gambling houses and saloons are built to entertain the workers, and gambling is soon legalized.
- 1950s** Land near Las Vegas is used by the government to test nuclear weapons.
