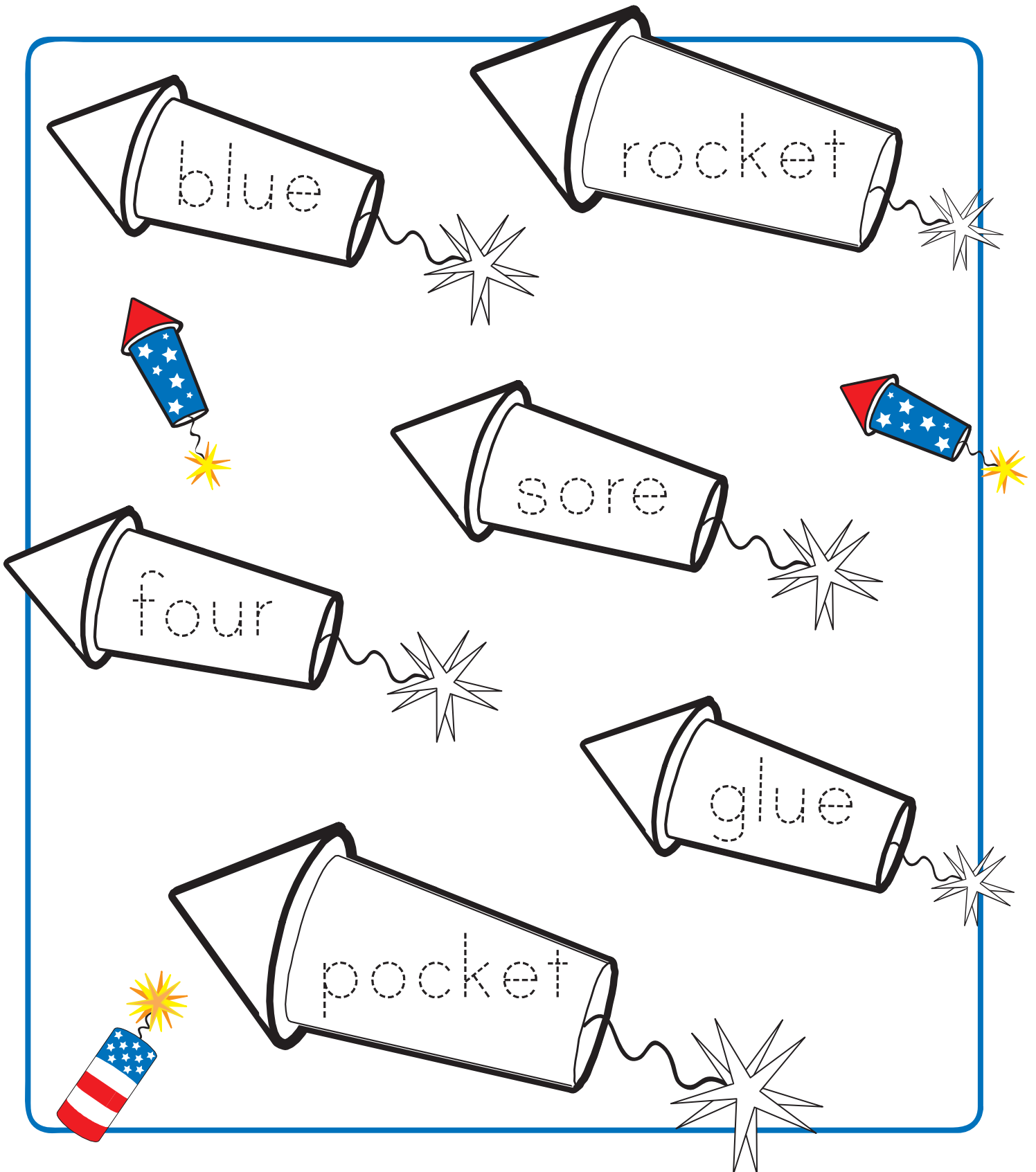

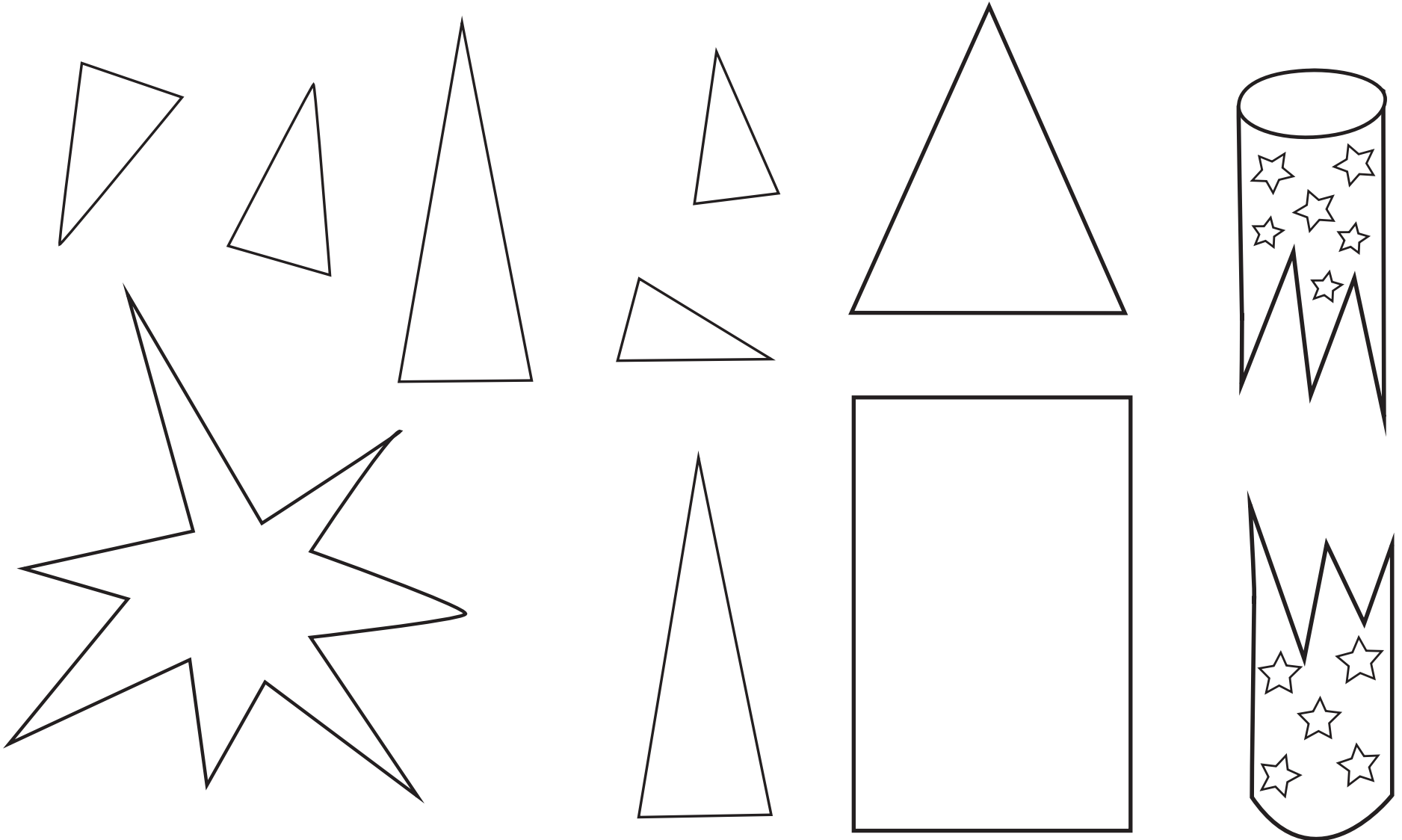




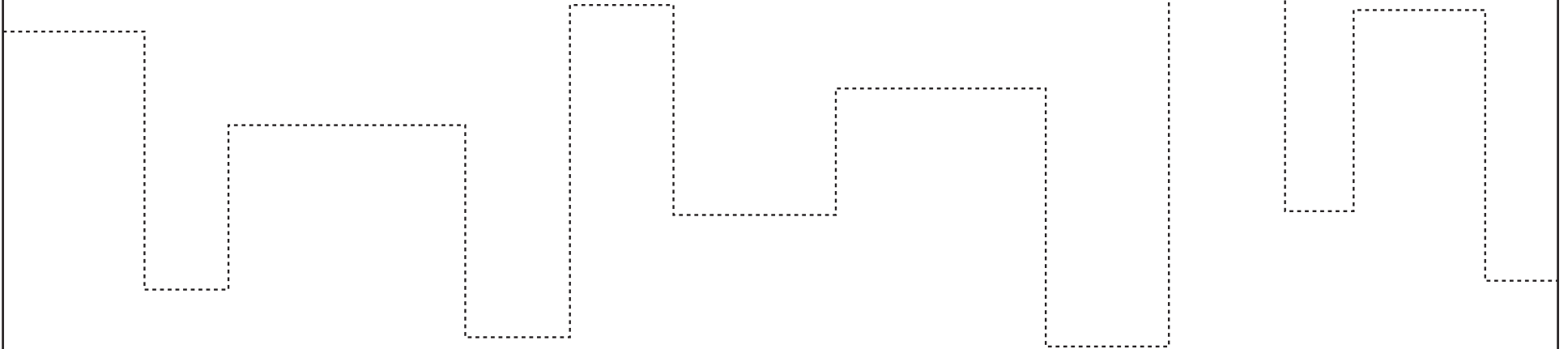
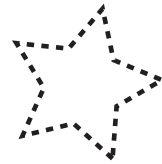
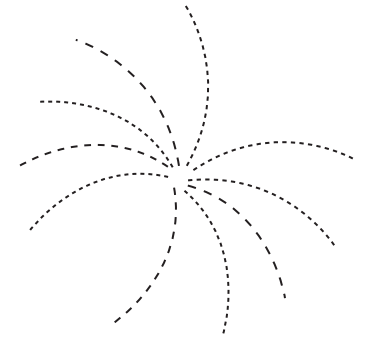
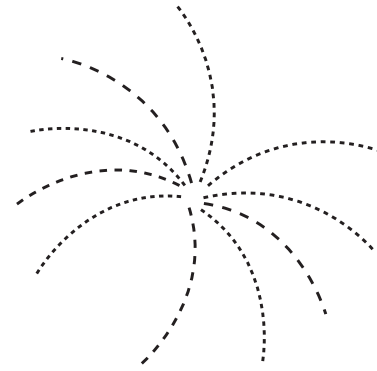
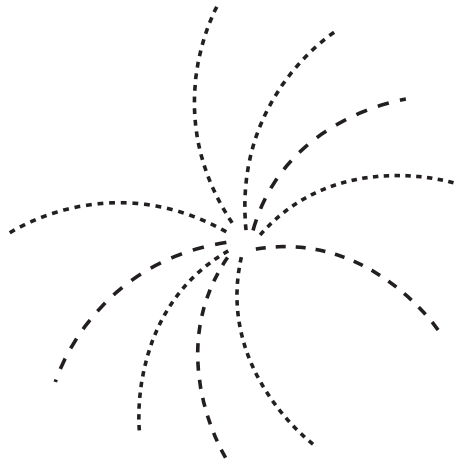
Design your own Fireworks

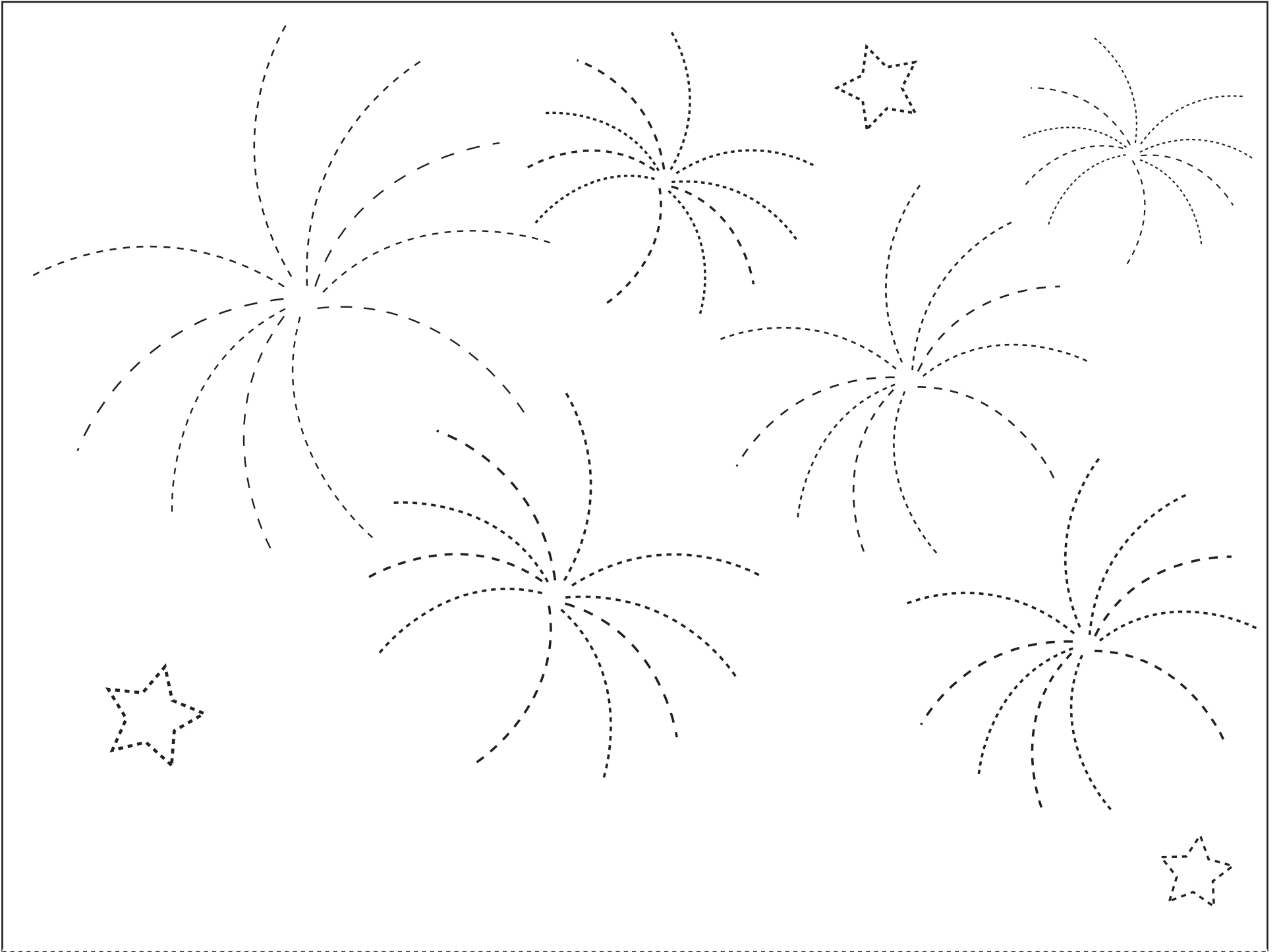
