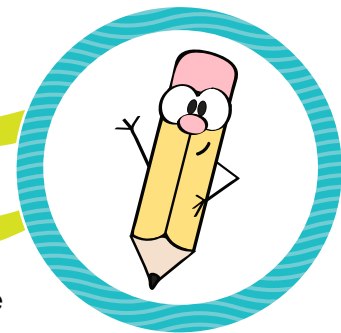

Look at the example below. Read each of the questions and solve the problem. Make sure to show your work!

ANSWER SHEET

Example:

At the zoo there were 4 hummingbirds, 3 finches, and 2 parrots. How many birds were there altogether?

$$4 + 3 + 2 = 9$$

1. At the beach there were 3 pink shells, 5 blue shells, and 2 yellow shells. How many shells were there altogether?

$$3 + 5 + 2 = 10$$

2. While driving, Sam saw 2 blue cars, 3 red cars, and 4 yellow cars. How many cars did he see altogether?

$$2 + 3 + 4 = 9$$

3. At the apple orchard Alice picked 4 apples, her brother picked 2 apples, and her mom picked 5 apples. How many apples did they pick altogether?

$$4 + 2 + 5 = 11$$

4. Adam planted 6 beans, Sue planted 5 beans, and Alex planted 2 beans. How many beans did they plant altogether?

$$6 + 5 + 2 = 13$$
