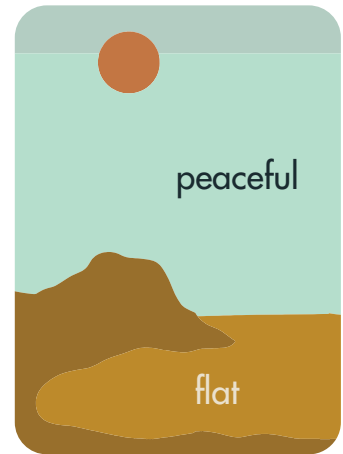


Adding Details with Adjectives

Adjectives are words that describe nouns and pronouns. Adjectives set a mood and add interest to your writing.

EXAMPLE: The sky was **peaceful** over the **flat** mesa.
