Punctuation marks are symbols that help readers understand a text. You can use punctuation marks such as commas, question marks, and periods to separate words, phrases, clauses, and sentences.

**DIRECTIONS:** A witch wants to cast an old spell, but the punctuation is missing. Use commas, periods, and question marks to help the witch add the correct punctuation to her note.
