Commas indicate pauses or breaks in a sentence. Use commas to do the following:

Set off nonrestrictive elements.

Trey's grandmother, who happens to be a world-class poet, teaches English classes at the community college.

Separate the name of a person being spoken to in a direct address.

Thank you, Mrs. Dawson, for your excellent presentation on tips for analyzing poetry.

Separate coordinate adjectives.

Her exceptional, well-regarded book of poems won a Nobel Prize in Literature.

Separate two independent clauses connected by a coordinating conjunction.

Students can complete their poetry analysis during study hall, or they can choose to do it at home.

Set off interjections and asides.

Oh my, that was quite a surprising turn of events!

It was hard to hear, given the constant chatter around me, why Trey's grandmother stopped writing.
