### Words in Group 1:

**munch    gasp    moan    chomp**

How do these words go together? **These are sounds that might be made by people.**

Word: **moan**

How might an author use this word in his or her writing?

**An author might use this when someone is hurt, to show pain.**

### Words in Group 2:

**fizz    splash    bang    varoom    sizzle**

How do these words go together? **These are sounds made by objects.**

Word: **splash**

How might an author use this word in his or her writing?

**An author might use this word to represent the sound of water, such as a person jumping into a pool.**

### Words in Group 3:

**buzz    meow    bark**

How do these words go together? **These words represent animal sounds.**

Word: **buzz**

How might an author use this word in his or her writing?

**An author might use this word to show the sound of a bee near a flower or the sound of a fly near a person's ear.**
