

ANCIENT INDIA MAP

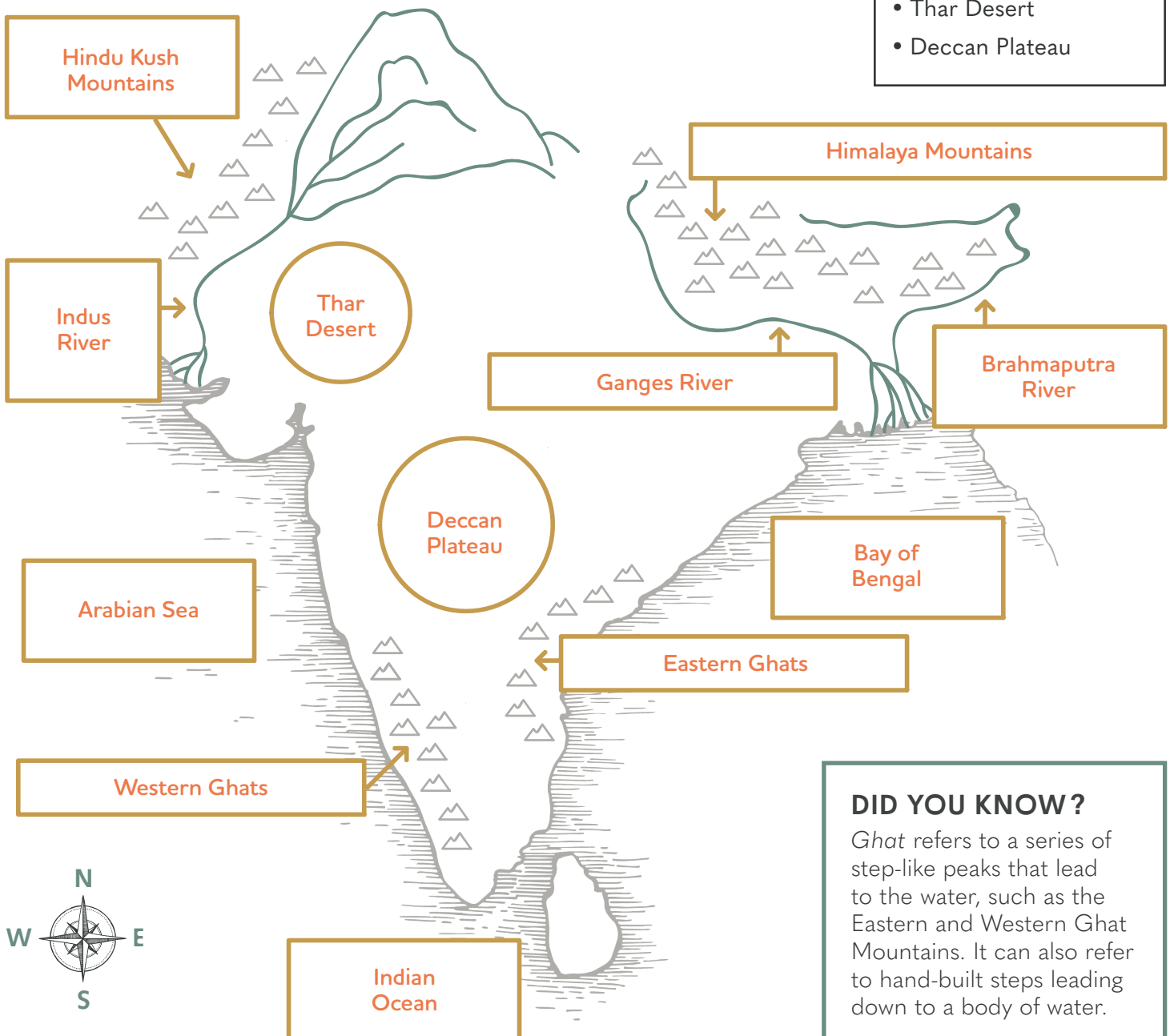
LABEL PHYSICAL FEATURES

India's diverse geography influenced the location of early settlements on the subcontinent. Rivers carrying nutrient-rich silt from the mountains created fertile river valleys. As early as 4500 BCE, the first known settlements developed in the Indus River Valley. By 3000 BCE, people also settled near the Ganges River.
