

The Shiniest Apple: Cause and Effect

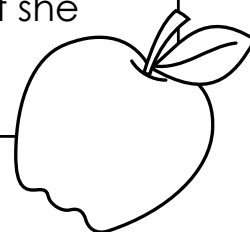
