
U.S. History Riddle:

- **T** U.S. Astronaut Neil Armstrong is the very first person to walk on the moon.
- M Hijacked planes crash into the Pentagon, the World Trade Center, and a Pennsylvania field.
- The Battle of Wounded Knee, the final battle between Native Americans and U.S. troops, is fought.
- **T** President John Adams and his wife, Abigail, are the first family to move into the White House.
- Sandra Day O'Connor is the first woman nominated to serve on the U.S. Supreme Court.
