
How Many Eyes Do Honey Bees Have?

Did you know that bees have five eyes? They have two compound eyes and three tiny ocelli eyes.



The two compound eyes on a bee are made up of thousands of small lenses, or facets. These small facets help form one complete picture.

The three small eyes on top of the bee's head are called ocelli. This word means "little eye" in Latin. These eyes are used for navigation and help bees stay stable while they are flying in the air.

Bees can't see red like humans do. Instead, they can see ultraviolet light, which helps them identify flowers to pollinate.


Bees have hair growing out of their eyes!




Help Sandy Bee on Time


Sandy needs to be up in the morning at 6:00 AM.




He has to eat his breakfast at 8:15 AM.




His flying lessons start at 9:45 AM.
