

Future to Present Tense: Verbs That End in Y #2

Rules:

If a verb ends with a **vowel** before -y, add -s for the present tense (happening now).

If a verb ends with a **consonant** before -y, remove the y and add -ies.

Directions: Change the verbs below from future tense to present tense.
The first one has been done for you.

1. He will **enjoy** the music.

He **enjoys** the music.

2. Eliana will **stay** at the hotel in June.

Eliana **stays** at the hotel in June.

3. Vivi will **worry** about her dog.

Vivi **worries** about her dog.

4. Max will **multiply** to solve.

Max **multiplies** to solve.

5. Declan will **try** to be careful.

Declan **tries** to be careful.

6. Jie will **reply** to her mother.

Jie **replies** to her mother.

7. Béa will **carry** her little brother.

Béa **carries** her little brother.

8. The shop will **display** the flag.

The shop **displays** the flag.
