# Changing the Future to the Present: Present Tense Verbs Ending in Y



If a verb ends with a *vowel* before -y, add -s for the third person present tense (happening now). If a verb ends with a *consonant* before -y, remove the y and add -ies.

Change the verbs below from future tense to present tense. The first one is done for you.

She will **play** the flute. ➡ She plays the flute.

He will **buy** a sandwich on Tuesday. ➡ He buys a sandwich on Tuesday.

The baby will **carry** the pacifier. ➡ The baby carries the pacifier.

Seongmin will **copy** the notes. ➡ Seongmin copies the notes.

MacKayla's dad will **fry** the potatoes. ➡ MacKayla's dad fries the potatoes.

The sprinkler will **spray** the cat. ➡ The sprinkler sprays the cat.

Jada will **fly** a kite. ➡ Jada flies a kite.
