- Max receives 3 red envelopes with gifts inside from family members. Two of the envelopes contain \$5, and the third one contains \$10. How much money did he gain in total?
- 6. He is saving \$45 to buy a new backpack. How much more money does he need after the red envelopes? _
- Max's sister is making paper lanterns with some of their friends. Each paper lantern requires 2 feet of paper. They want to make 10 lanterns. How many feet of paper will they need? <u>20 feet</u>
