**Civil disobedience** — To protest a company by refusing to buy their merchandise or use their service.

**Protest** — A public showing of disapproval for a rule or event, such as a march or rally.

**Demonstration** — To separate a group of people by race, gender or other factor.

**Nonviolence** — To disapprove of something in a public way.

**Segregate** — The act of trying to bring about change without using violence.

**Boycott** — Disobeying or refusing to follow a law without breaking any others.

**Assassination** — The murder of a political figure.
