An *informative paragraph* gives the reader information about a topic. A good informative paragraph follows a simple structure. It is strongest when it includes all the parts!

HOOK (yellow)
A statement or question that gets your reader interested in reading the rest of your paragraph.
TOPIC SENTENCE (green)
A statement that introduces the main idea.
DETAILS (blue)
Sentences that give your reader three details that support the main idea.
CONCLUSION (red)
A closing sentence that sums up or concludes your paragraph.
