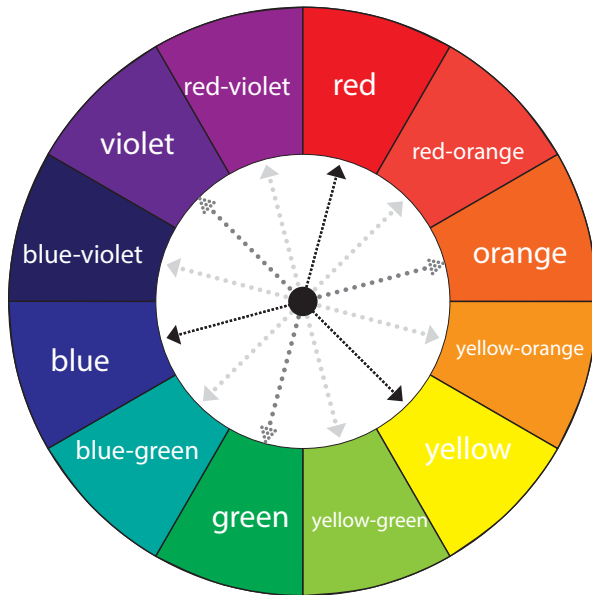


Color Wheel for Kids!

Do you like to mix colors? Did you know mixed colors have names and groups? They do!



Answer the following questions using the color wheel.

1. What two primary colors are mixed to make the secondary color orange?
(Hint: Remember to skip over the tertiary colors!)

red and yellow

2. What two colors are mixed to make yellow-green?
(hint: one is a primary and the other is a secondary)

green and yellow

3. How many tertiary colors are there in the color wheel?

six

4. Opposite colors are straight across from each other like red and green. What color is opposite blue on the color wheel?

orange

The first group is called
.....→ **PRIMARY COLORS**

red
yellow
blue

The second group is called
.....→ **SECONDARY COLORS**
these are made by mixing the primary colors that “sandwich” them on the color wheel (skip over the tertiary colors!)

orange
green
violet

The third group is called
.....→ **TERTIARY COLORS**
these are made by mixing the primary color and secondary color that “sandwich” them on the color wheel

red-orange
yellow-orange
yellow-green
blue-green
blue-violet
red-violet
