

COMMAS

Commas are used in many occasions. We often use commas to separate words or groups of three words or more. Commas are also used to separate two adjectives in a sentence. Look at the example below and then try to add commas where they are needed in the following sentences.

EXAMPLE

1. The fruit salad has oranges bananas apples and pears in it.

The fruit salad has oranges , bananas , apples , and pears in it.

2. Frank Jake Dave and Kevin are all on the soccer team.

Frank , Jake , Dave , and Kevin are all on the soccer team.

3. Paula is a lovely quiet girl.

Paula is a lovely , quiet girl.

4. To receive an allowance you must do your homework pull the weeds and clean your room.

To receive an allowance you must do your homework , pull the weeds , and clean your room.

5. The beautiful misty morning arrived at the right moment.

The beautiful , misty morning arrived at the right moment.

6. I am going to make eggs waffles toast and coffee for breakfast.

I am going to make eggs , waffles , toast , and coffee for breakfast.

Commas are also commonly used to separate the day of the month from the year!
