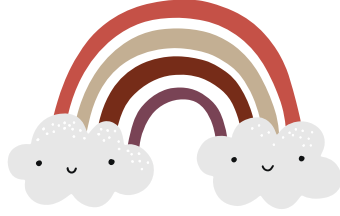

Conjunctions #4



A **conjunction** is a word that joins together words, phrases, or parts of sentences. Some common conjunctions include: **and, or, but, for, nor, yet, so.**

EXAMPLE: I like to play baseball, but I also like swimming.

1. Greg owns a fish, a dog, and a cat, so he knows how to take care of pets.
2. The taxi was waiting outside for Sally, but she hadn't finished packing.

5. The Johnsons don't know how to swim, so they don't go to the beach or pool.
