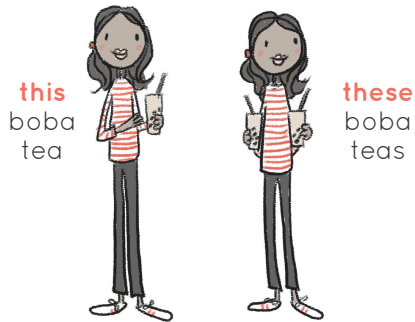


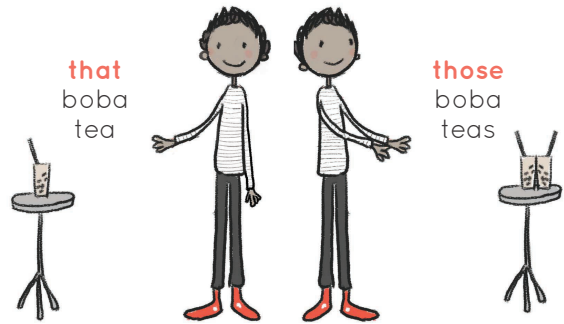
# Demonstrative Pronouns **Answers**

**Demonstrative pronouns** point out a person, place, thing, or idea.

**This** and **these** point out things that are *near* the speaker.



**That** and **those** point out things that are *far from* the speaker.



**This** and **that** are singular. • **These** and **those** are plural.
