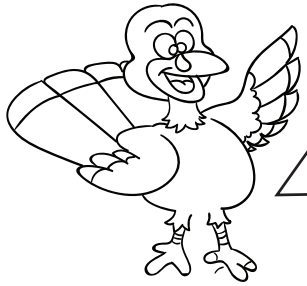

Describes: used

Adverb: expertly

Describes: carves

Describes: save
