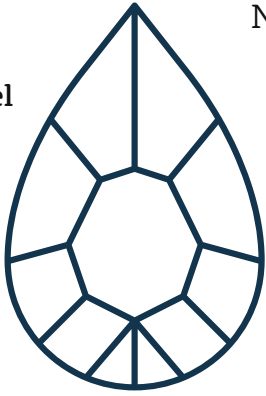

Vowel Diphthongs: *Ew*

A *diphthong* is a combination of two letters that produces a complex vowel sound.

Example: EW makes the sound in jewel.
