Donald Trump served as the 45th president of the United States of America. Read about Donald Trump's life and story. After you read, complete the sentences.

Donald Trump was born in Queens, New York, in 1946, the son of a real estate developer, and one of four children. His family descended from German and Scottish immigrants.

Trump attended school in Queens and later Manhattan, then studied economics at the Wharton School in Pennsylvania. In 1968, he began his career at his father's real estate company, E. Trump & Son. When he was promoted as president, he renamed it The Trump Organization. In 1978 he launched his Manhattan real estate business, which eventually developed projects around the world, including casinos, hotels, and private residences. Other ventures include the Miss Universe pageant and Trump University.

In addition to his real estate development business, Trump has published several books, including *Trump: The Art of the Deal*. He also produced and hosted a television show called *The Apprentice*. He is also a golfing enthusiast.

Trump is the father of five children: Donald Jr., Ivanka, Eric, Tiffany, and Barron. He is married to Melania Knauss, a Slovenian-American former model.

Following a campaign against Democratic candidate Hillary Clinton, Donald Trump, a Republican, was elected the 45th U.S. President in 2016. He served one term in office from January 21, 2017, to January 21, 2021.
