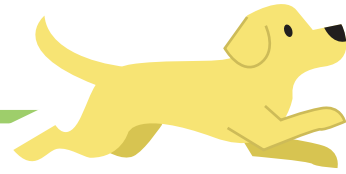


Explain the Problem
