
Factor Tree Answer Key

Factors are two or more numbers that can be multiplied together to get a new number.

In multiplication, we have:

- **Prime numbers**, which are whole numbers that have no other factor but 1 and itself.
- **Composite numbers**, which are whole numbers that have have other factors besides 1 and itself.




Factors: 5, 9, 3

Prime Numbers: 5, 3


Composite Numbers: 45, 9


