

Fill in the Blank: Superlative Adjectives



Superlative adjectives compare more than two things.

We can create superlative adjectives by adding -est to the end of adjectives. If the word ends with y, change the y to i before adding -est.

*Example: I think the purple flower is the **prettiest**.*

1. The drums were the loudest instrument in the band. (loud)
2. Mrs. Johnson is the oldest person in the room. (old)
3. Jenna is the tallest person on the team. (tall)
4. Will went sledding on the coldest day of winter. (cold)
5. Jake lives in the largest city in the state of Texas. (large)
6. The heaviest rainfall usually occurs in April. (heavy)
7. Marco's Pizza is the busiest during lunchtime. (busy)
8. Mr. Lopez's earliest math class begins at 8:00. (early)
