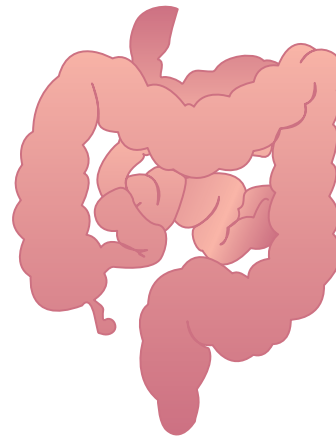
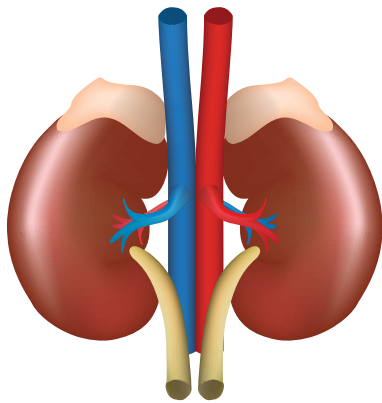


The Body's Filtration System: Kidneys and Intestines
