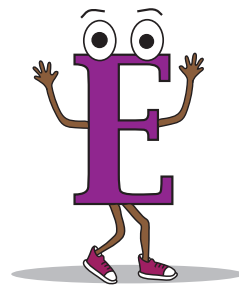


Answer Key**Final /e/: Word Sort**
