Factors are numbers that you multiply together to get another number. For example, since $1 \times 8 = 8$ and $2 \times 4 = 8$, you know that the factors of 8 are 1, 2, 4, and 8.

Order of factor pairs may vary.

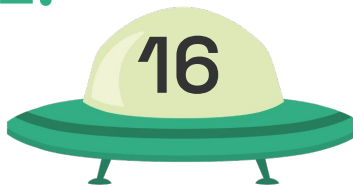
