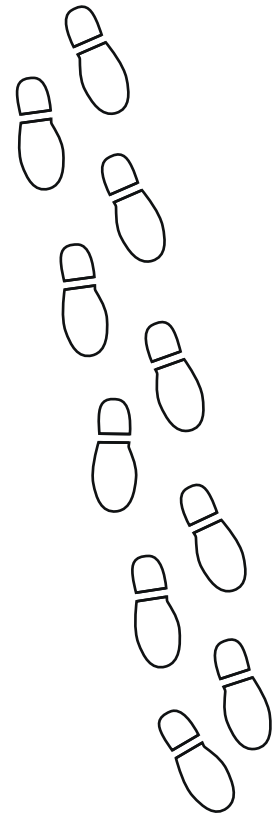
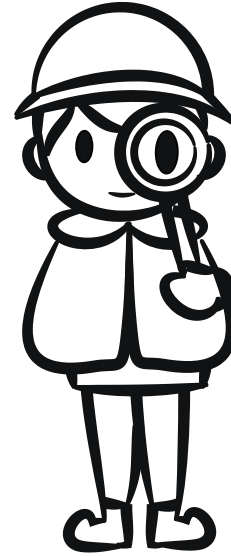


Find the Verbs
