## FIX THE FRAGMENTS

A sentence fragment is only part of a complete sentence. It is missing either a subject or a predicate.

A complete sentence expresses a complete thought. It has a subject and a predicate.

**EXAMPLE:** Ate the cupcake. This sentence is missing a subject. **EXAMPLE:** Alex ate the cupcake. This sentence has a subject and a predicate.
