| Questions | Information We Want to Know | Example |
|-------------------------|---|---|
| When did it happen? | Information about time or occasion | The Boston Tea Party took place in 1773. |
| Where did it happen? | Information about location or place | The event was in the Boston Harbor. |
| Why did it happen? | Information about the reason something exists or happened | Colonists were protesting the new tea taxes placed on them by the British king. |
| How did it happen? | Information about the way something is done | They threw chests of tea in the water. |
