## **Writing Topic Sentences**

Great writers are focused, stay on topic, and organize their paragraphs. It is helpful to follow correct paragraph structure.

- A topic sentence tells the main idea of the paragraph or text.
- Supporting details follow the topic sentence. They give more details and evidence.
- A concluding sentence at the end of the paragraph ties it all together.

Topic Sentence	There are three types of honeybees in a hive.
Supporting Detail 1	The queen bee, the leader, is able to lay up to 2,000 eggs in one day.
Supporting Detail 2	Another type of bee is the worker bee, which gathers food.
Supporting Detail 3	Last, a drone is a male bee that does not have a stinger.
Concluding Sentence	Each type of honeybee is important to the hive.

Topic Sentence	Different parts of a plant have different jobs.
Supporting Detail 1	The roots of a plant take in water and nutrients while holding the plant in place.
Supporting Detail 2	A plant's stem holds it up and carries food, water, and nutrients to the rest of the plant.
Supporting Detail 3	The leaves are used to make the plant's food.
Concluding Sentence	All parts of a plant play an important role in helping the plant grow.
TOPIC	2. Landforms
Topic Sentence	Landforms are formed over time by different natural forces.
Supporting Detail 1	Mountains and hills are often formed by the movement of the Earth's crust.
Supporting Detail 2	Valleys can be shaped when a river wears down the land over time.
Supporting Detail 3	Some islands are made by volcanoes under the ocean.
Concluding Sentence	These natural forces can take millions of years to form new landforms.
