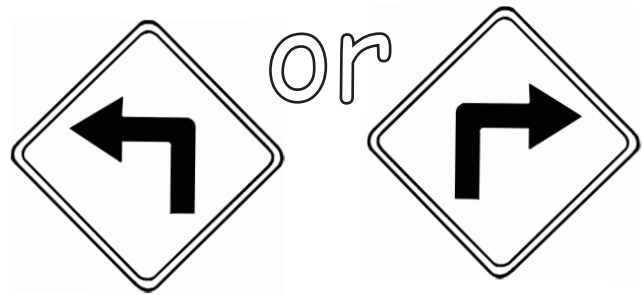
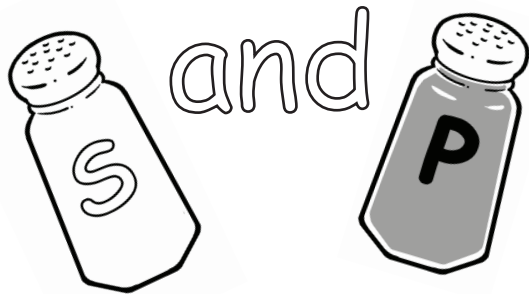


# CONJUNCTIONS
