

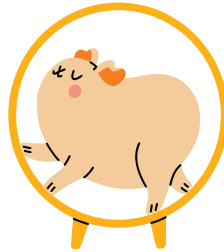
Prepositions of Place

A preposition is a word that links nouns, pronouns, or other phrases in a sentence.
A preposition of place shows where something is.
