

Grammar: Adjectives



An **adjective** describes a noun. It tells you *which, what kind, what color, or how many*.

Examples: I have two dogs.
I petted the brown dog.

Write the noun that each adjective describes.

- We took a ride on a big, blue sailboat.
Big describes the noun sailboat
Blue describes the noun sailboat
- The cloudy sky was dark and gray.
Cloudy describes the noun sky
Dark describes the noun sky
Gray describes the noun sky
- The strong wind scared me, but the brave captain kept us safe.
Strong describes the noun wind
Brave describes the noun captain
- We saw many large birds, including two albatrosses.
Large describes the noun birds
Two describes the noun albatrosses

- I like the pink **flowers** best.
- They live in the small green **house** on the corner.
- We ordered a large **pizza**.
- Jenna went on a two-week **vacation**.
