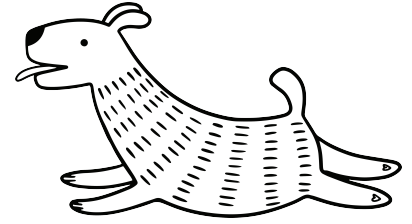


# Great Grammar:

## Subject-Verb Agreement

Let's learn about subject and verb agreement! The subject and verb must agree in number: both must be singular, or both must be plural.



For example:

**Singular:** The dog chases the cat. **Plural:** The dogs chase the cat.
