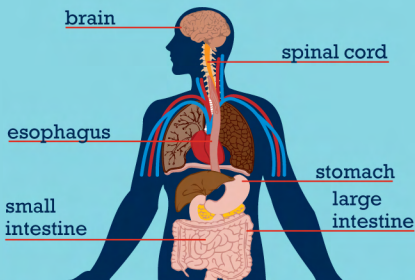


15. GUTSY MOVE

16. A BUG'S LIFE

My Butterfly's Life Cycle

If you are a butterfly, you have to go through a bunch of stages before you fly off. At first, my insect started out as a small **egg** on a leaf. Soon it hatched a small fuzzy caterpillar, also called a **larva**, which grew and grew and ate and ate. When it got big enough, it sealed itself up in a **cocoon**. At this stage it's called a **pupa** or a chrysalis.

After a couple of weeks, the butterfly or **adult** insect emerged and flew off. The whole process of change from caterpillar to butterfly is called **metamorphosis**.
