The <u>CODE OF HAMMURABI</u>

was an extensive set of laws handed down four thousand years ago

by King <u>HAMMURABI</u> of Babylon. By many, it is

considered to be the oldest code of law of its length (over 200 laws).

This set of laws also contained the "<u>EYE</u> for an <u>EYE</u>"

type of punishment.

The Corpus Juris (Body of Civil Law) is also known as <u>CODE OF</u>

JUSTINIAN. It is a collection of fundamental works in the philosophy

of law. It was issued from 529 to 534 by the order of Justinian I, East-

ern <u>ROMAN</u> Emperor. One of the laws stated that a

person was innocent until proven <u>GUILTY</u>.

The <u>MAGNA CARTA</u> is a charter of liberty and political rights. It was originally issued in 1215 by <u>KING JOHN</u> of <u>ENGLAND</u> to appease his rebellious barons and other nobility. It kept the monarchy in check, by giving more liberties to the nobility. It is seen as an important document of English constitutional practice.
