

\$12 + \$5 = \$17

2. How much more money does the dinosaur cost than the unicorn?

.15 - 10 = 5. The dinosaur costs 5 more than the unicorn.

3. What three different things can you buy to use all of your \$17?

blocks \$5 + skates \$8 + teddy bear \$4 = \$17 duck \$5 + skates \$8 + teddy bear \$4 = \$17 hat \$7 + volleyball \$6 + teddy bear \$4 = \$17 blocks \$5 + duck \$5 + hat \$7 = \$17

Students can also subtract each object from \$17 to determine their three objects.

4. Share your answers with a partner. Discuss the operations (addition or subtraction) you used. Then tell how you know you have the right answer.
