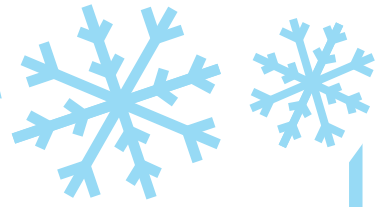

Holiday Shopping 2



Help buy presents for friends this holiday season! Answer the questions using the bookshelf filled with toys. Use drawings to help you solve the problems.



1. What is the total for the unicorn and the pair of skates?

ANSWER KEY

$$\$10 + \$8 = \$18$$

2. You are trying to buy as many different toys as possible. You have \$20. What toys can you get?

I can buy 4 gifts.

$$\$20 - \$4 \text{ teddy bear} = \$16 \text{ left}$$

$$\$16 - \$5 \text{ blocks} = \$11 \text{ left}$$

$$\$11 - \$5 \text{ duck} = \$6 \text{ left}$$

$$\$6 - \$6 \text{ volleyball} = \$0 \text{ left over}$$

or

$$\$4 \text{ teddy} + \$5 \text{ blocks} + \$5 \text{ duck} + \$6 \text{ volleyball} = \$20$$

How much money will you have left over?

I will not have any money left over after I buy one teddy bear, a set of blocks, a duck, and a volleyball. I could not buy all teddy bears (\$4) because all the toys I buy need to be different.

3. Share your answers with a partner. Talk about if you used addition or subtraction for your answers.

Tell how you know you have the right answer.
