- Shade the number that is 30 more than 2.
- Shade the number that is one less than 40.
- Shade the number that is half of 86.
- Shade the number that is 2 less than the value of 2 quarters.
- Shade the number that is 6×9 .
- Shade the number that is $5 \times 10 + 7$.
- Shade the numbers between 64 and 67.
- Shade the value of 3 quarters.
- Shade the number that is $2 \times 30 + 16$.
- Shade the value of 1 dollar minus 15 cents.
- Shade the value of 8 tens and 6 ones.
- Shade the numbers between 90 and 101.
