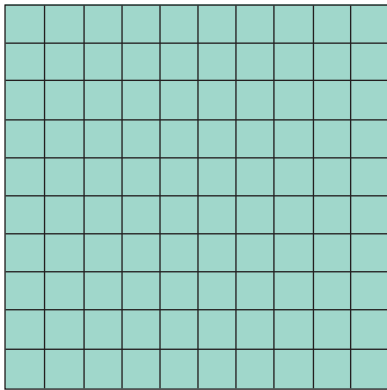
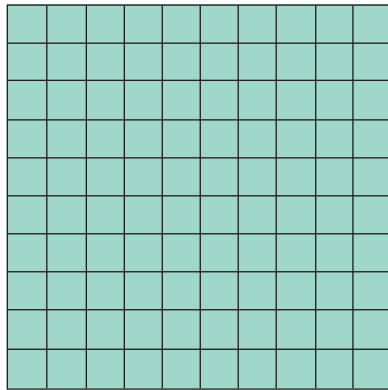


Hundreds, Tens, and Ones

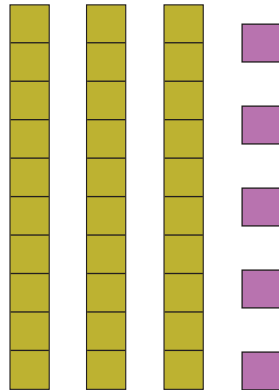
Place value is the value of a digit based on its position in a number.






