An **illustration** is a picture or drawing that usually accompanies text.

A **caption** is the text near a picture or illustration that provides information about the image.

*A caption includes **nouns** and **associated pronouns** to explain the illustration.

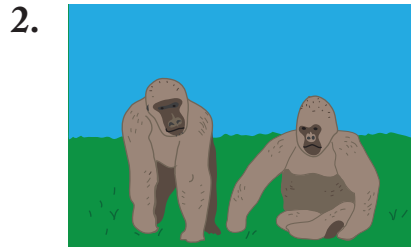
Usually a tornado is in the form of a funnel-shape. Sometimes it looks like a rope.

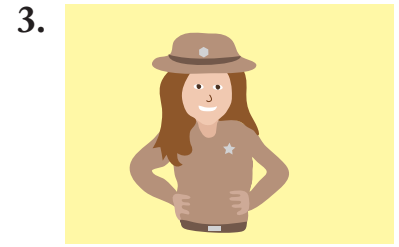

The hurricane is near Florida. It has very strong winds.



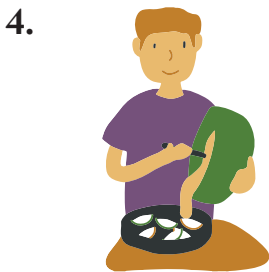
The gorillas are at the zoo. They are going to be moved for safety during the storm.
