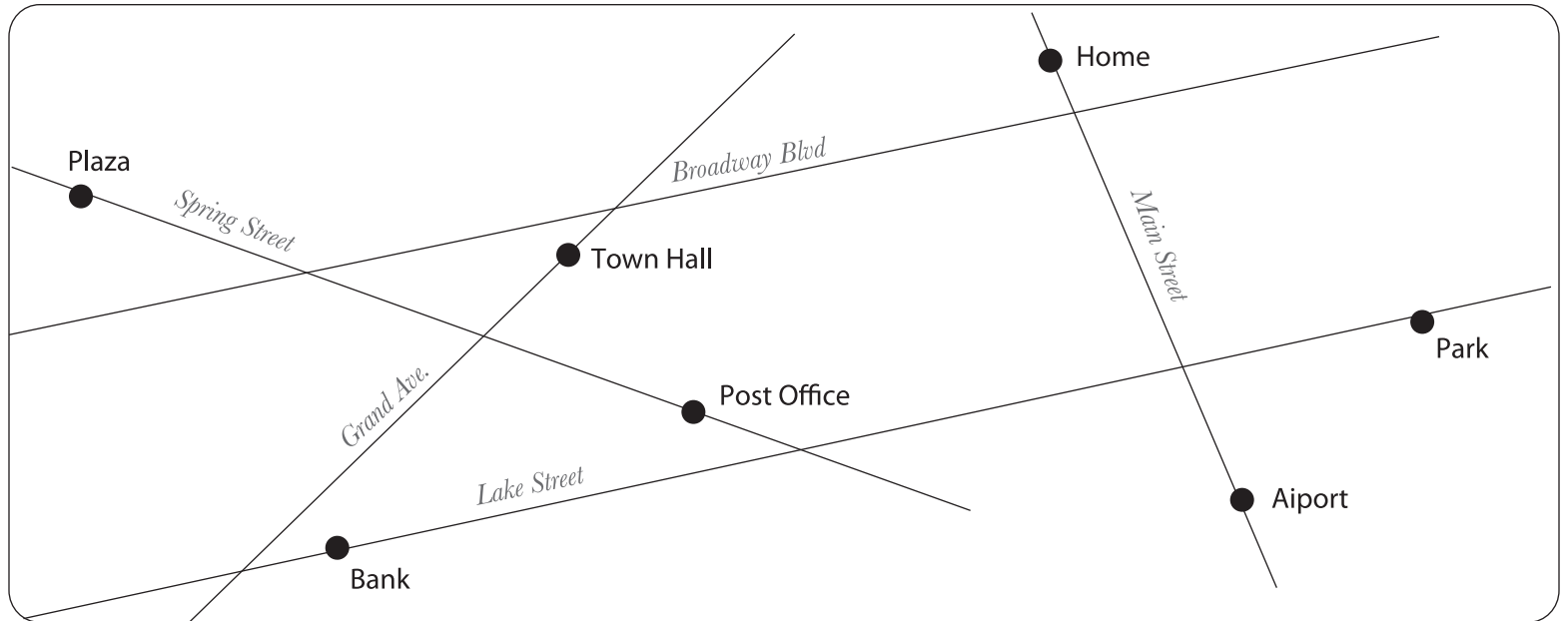


# Intermediate Directions

Use intermediate directions (northeast, southeast, southwest, and northwest) to provide directions on the map below.



1. In order to get to the park from home, Michael will go southeast on Main Street and northeast on Lake Street.
2. After Jenny's plane lands, she wants to go from the airport to the plaza to meet her best friend. She will go northwest on Main Street, southwest on Lake Street, and northwest on Spring Street.
3. Mr. Samuels wants to attend a town hall meeting, then go to the post office. He will walk southwest on Grand Ave. and southeast on Spring Street.
4. Evelyn is taking a morning run from the plaza to home. She runs southeast on Spring Street, then northeast on Lake Street, and northwest on Main Street.
5. Kelly walks her dog from the park to town hall. They walk southwest on Lake Street, northwest on Spring Street, and northeast on Grand Ave.
6. David needs money to buy a plane ticket. After going to the bank, he drives northeast on Lake Street and southeast on Main Street.
7. Mr. Goldberg walks home from the town hall. He walks northeast on Grand Ave, northeast on Broadway Blvd, and northwest on Main Street.
